In 1994 an archaeological project began with the goal of locating the remains of the original James Fort, ca. 1607–1624. Twenty years of exploration have established the location of the fort and principal buildings and recovered more than 1.5 million artifacts. The project has rewritten our understanding of early settlers' daily life and purpose and their relations with the Native Americans that they encountered. The research project continues to bring to life a narrative of human endeavor and perseverance that laid the foundations of British America
